A 1/3 deposit is required on all hunts, of which 50% is non-refundable and 50% is refundable up to 120 days before the hunt date. The \$150 Non-Resident Hunter Preservation Fund fee is also due with deposit, and that check should be made out to the Alaska Professional Hunter's Association (APHA). This fund was established by the APHA to help fund efforts to ensure that non-resident hunters will continue to have hunting opportunities in Alaska. Hunting licenses and tags are not included in hunt prices.

Our sheep and goat hunt units cover a vast area of the Chugach Mts. It's rugged country, so get in shape. Your fly-in day is not included against your hunting day. We will supply all transportation and meals after your arrival in Anchorage. Your hunt is considered complete when you take your contracted animals, regardless of days left in hunt. You're welcome to stay at our cabin or base camp as our guests until your departure date. All of our Dall sheep and Mt. Goat hunts are currently draw hunts in the Chugach Mountains, which includes units 13D and 14C. The draw application period runs from November 1st to December 17th, the year prior to the hunt year; as in, apply November 1st to December 17st, 2019 to hunt in 2020.

Our Peninsula brown bear hunts are in the Port Heiden area of the Alaska Peninsula, about midway between King Salmon and Cold Bay on the Bristol Bay, Bering Sea side of the Peninsula. You will be responsible for your own transportation to Port Heiden.

All other hunts are based out of our Wasilla home and you will fly into Anchorage.
